

Re-Demonstration Policy

Students will be allowed to redemonstrate summative assessments if:

- the student encounters unforeseen and uncontrollable circumstances that the teacher agrees may have contributed to a poor summative result,
- the summative result is inconsistent with the formative evidence and the student has proven to be engaged in learning and responsive to feedback.

In instances where one or both above-mentioned criteria exist, requirements for re-demonstration will be left to the discretion of the applicable teacher. This requirement may include spending time in a tutorial with the teacher, doing homework, and it may mean the student may have to miss extra-curricular activities, such as intramurals, leaving school early to attend Tornado sports events, and etc. TMSS is committed to learning.

Teachers will communicate with the student's family that re-demonstration was necessary.
