 **Accounting 10/20** – calculator, red and blue pens, ruler


 **Animation30, Computer Science 20/30, Design Studies 10/20** – headphones/earbuds for computer use

 **Band 10/20/30** - 1" binder with dividers - no fancy binders with zippers. (There is not enough shelf space)




Biology 30 – Large Binder, Paper, Pens, Pencils, Eraser, Calculator & Ruler


 **Chemistry 30** – Large Binder, Paper, Pens, Pencils (A MUST FOR CHEM), Eraser, Calculator


 (needs exponent and log function - students are not allowed to use any other device for calculations) **Design Studies** - Pencil, Markers

 **English 10/20/30** –at least 2 different colored pens, pencil, current library card

 **Financial Literacy 30** – Scientific calculator

 **Foods 10 /20/30** – binder, large reusable container, duo tang for cookbook, duo tang for lab book, calculator, glue stick, pencil crayons, markers, scissors, white out, pencils, pens, highlighters

 **Forensics 20-** binder, pens, pencils, erasers, white-out, markers/pencil crayons (bring old ones from previous years), 1-2 pkg index/recipe cards

 **Healthcare 30** - pencil, pens (not green), eraser, glue stick, highlighters, whiteout, markers, pencil crayons, 2-3 pkg index/recipe cards (very important for learning terminology)

 **Health Science 20** - Large Binder, Paper, Pens, Pencils & Eraser



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- 👉 **History 10/20/30** – Binder, Paper, dividers, pens, highlighters
- 👉 **Psychology 20**- pencil, pens (not green), eraser, glue stick, highlighters, white-out, markers/pencil crayons (bring ones from previous years), 2-3 packages of index/recipe cards
- 👉 **Psychology 30** - pencils, pens (not green), eraser, glue stick, highlighters, white-out, markers/pencil crayons, 2-3 packages of index/recipe cards (white or colored)
- 👉 **Environmental Science 20** – Calculator, highlighters, markers/pencil crayons (can be used from previous years)
- 👉 **Life Transitions 30** –pencils, pens (not green), eraser, glue stick, highlighters, white-out, markers/pencil crayons (bring old ones from previous years)
- 👉 **Math Workplace & Apprenticeship 10** – Calculator with trig functions and percent (no other device is allowed), ruler with both centimeters and inches, pencils (A MUST FOR DOING MATH), erasers, pens (not green), highlighters, white-out, markers/pencil crayons (bring old ones from other years)
- 👉 **Math Foundations & Pre-Calculus 10** – Scientific calculator (with trig functions on it), geometry kit, Dry Erase markers (1 or 2), ruler (with cm and in), graph paper
- 👉 **Math Workplace 20** - scientific calculator (with trig functions on it), geometry set, ruler with cm and inches, Dry Erase markers (1 or 2)
- 👉 **Math Foundations 20/30, Pre-Calculus 20/30, Calculus 30** - TI-83 or TI-84 graphing calculator (can be used) (Math 20 Foundations Geometry Set) Dry Erase markers (1 or 2), ruler (with both cm and in), graph paper
- 👉 **Physical Science 20** - Large Binder, Paper, Pens, Pencils, Eraser & Calculator (needs exponent and trig functions - students are not allowed to use any other device for calculations)
- 👉 **Physics 30** – Scientific Calculator (with trig functions on it) Ruler (with cm and in), highlighters, graph paper
- 👉 **Science 10** – calculator, ruler, graph paper, highlighters
 - 👉 **Visual Arts 10** – 100-page tape-bound sketch pad, pencils and erasers, binder. You are welcome to bring any art supplies such as artist pencils, paintbrushes, crayons, charcoal etc. but are not a requirement as they will be provided in the art room.
 - 👉 **Visual Arts 20/30** – 1 fine tip black sharpie, 1 glue stick, pencils, white eraser, ruler, scissors, pencil sharpener, pencil crayons, markers.
- 👉 **Wellness/Phys Ed 20/30** – Indoor non-marking athletic shoes (NO BOARD SHOES), Shorts or sweats, t-shirt or tank top (School Appropriate clothing only please), Deodorant and shower supplies (towel, shampoo), duotang or 1” binder.
