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Sewing 9:

These supplies are strongly recommended. Having your own items means you do not have to wait Students tend to like projects more when they get to select their own fabric. Supplies will be available in the lab

You can purchase supplies at Save Max in Tisdale or Fabricland in Regina/PA/Saskatoon. The following items need to be stored in a container with a tight-fitting lid (margarine, tupperware, Glad, etc.): ☐ duotang for notes and handouts ☐ Straight pins in a container or a cushion (a cushion is best) ☐ Seam ripper □ **Thread if you want the colour to match your fabrics. Black or white thread is supplied ☐ 1 pkg.of 1" non-roll elastic for PJ pants Fabric: You will make one pencil case OR one drawstring bag along with pajama pants. If you have extra time, you are welcome to complete additional projects or mending. A) Pencil case: 0.25m of cotton or poly-cotton or a "fat quarter" for quilting. Please wash and dry. **OR** A) Drawstring Bag: 1m of study cotton/poly cotton or twill fabric. Please wash and dry

- **AND**
- B) PJ Pants: Most students use flannel or polar fleece. Please avoid plaids. If you select fabric with a pattern or words that only go one way, you will need extra fabric. Please wash and dry.
 - 150cm/60" wide = 1.5 m
 - 115cm/45" wide = 2.5 m
